A new petition will be filed if AT&T is able to address these issues, or if AT&T is able to find a different location for a facility.

AT&T submits that any comments in this case are moot in light of this motion to dismiss. Since no prehearing conference has yet to take place, dismissal without prejudice is appropriate at this juncture.
