

East Hardwick Needs

Safety

- Speeding is the Most Frequent Issue Addressed in Several Annual EHNO Surveys
Radar Speed Signs Are Proven to Reduce Speeding
Request Three (3) Moveable Radar Signs To Move Between 5 Intersecting Streets (Main, School, Church, Cedar, and Brickhouse)
- Sidewalks are the 2nd Most Frequently Mentioned Issue
Sidewalks Randomly and Erratically Covered in Asphalt
Drainage Is Poor and Collapsing
Poor Drainage Is Aggravated By The Street Being Higher than Sidewalks
Existing Sidewalks Need Repair
New Sidewalks – Hardwick has over 2.5 mi of Sidewalk - East Hardwick .25 mi.
EH Needs an Additional .2 mi. for a total of .45 mi.
- Guardrails For Streets From RT16 With Sharp Drops Toward Lamoille River
School St – Close to a 50 ft. Plunge To River – Setback 2' to 6' From Street Edge
Cedar St – 20-30 ft. Plunge – Setback 1' to 3' From Street Edge

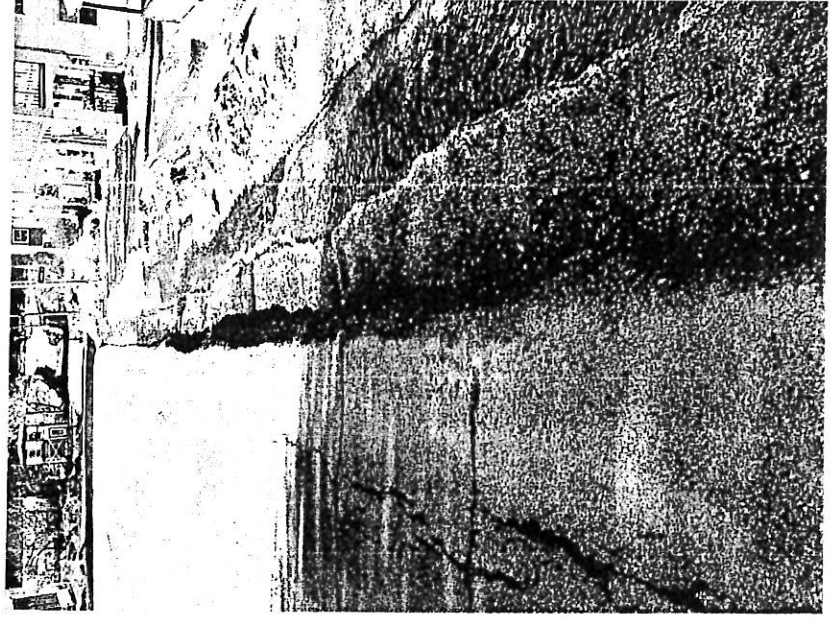
