Does the applicant have funds already "in reserve" for this project so that ARPA funds could complete it?

How much money has been raised?

How much money is in the pipeline?

What other funding resources could support this project?

Federal grant funding?

State grant funding?

Private philanthropic funding?

Will the project create something that will need maintenance?

If yes, who will maintain it?

The timeline

Does the requestor's timeline make sense?

Will the project fit into ARPA time constraints?

We must spend the ARPA money by the end of 2026.
