Eric said that the Town received a \$100,000 accessibility modification grant from the Vermont Community Development Program (VCDP) to help with the cost of installing an elevator to make the Jeudevine Memorial Library handicapped accessible. A final public hearing is required to give the community an opportunity to learn about the project and ask questions about the impact of the grant.

Jodi Lew-Smith explained that the funds were expended for the elevator in two payments of \$71,500 and \$28,500. The first amount paid for a large portion of the elevator purchase and the remainder went towards the installation. The elevator will provide critical access to the library. There are actually 3 levels of the library. It will give access to the old portion and the new portion of the library. The layout of the elevator and entrances will help anyone with mobility issues.

Some people are unable to use the current library, so it is going to open up opportunities for everyone to be able to utilize the library.
