

# Summer 2020 Recommendations from the Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Task Force and the Hardwick Planning Commission

- 1. Repaint the crosswalks in a high visibility color
- 2. Install a speed sign before Hardwick Downtown (prior to the Glenside intersection)
- 3. Install signage to direct cars to alternate parking
- 4. Stop, wait, and wave signs at the crosswalks
- 5. Install a crosswalk near the bridge on North Main Street (over the Lamoille River).
- 6. Educate younger riders about sidewalk and crosswalk safety.

#### Repaint the crosswalks in a high visibility color.











#### **Colored and Textured Crosswalk Design Treatments**

Colored and textured crosswalk design treatments are often used in village and downtown centers to improve the aesthetics of crosswalks. One of the MUTCD approved crosswalk patterns must be used to delineate the colored and/or textured area.


## Install a speed sign before the village (prior to the Glenside intersection).
