 - **A.** The Trust for Public Land has submitted one grant application for support funds; a second grant is in progress

 - **A.** Connor Manosh expressed interest in providing weekly data on water supply failures reported to NA Manosh
 - **B.** Lucy suggested contacting Dr. Dubigny-Giroux, UVM climatologist who is seeking data about climate-related events for academic study. She proposed that her department and the HCC develop a cooperative and collaborative relationship.
 - **C.** Rationale: sharing this information with Kristen Leahy will bring climate-related adverse-event resilience to municipal government agents to inform public policy and community education
