

Lineperson – Journeyman or Apprentice (Union Position)

Hardwick Electric Department (HED) is seeking an experienced **1st Class Journeyman or Apprentice Lineperson** to join our 6-person Electric Operations crew. The team maintains and improves **325 miles of overhead and underground distribution and transmission lines**, providing safe and reliable electric service to **4,350 customers**. Rate of pay is \$58.25 for Journeyman and ranges from \$33.21 to 51.63 for apprentice, depending upon experience and training of apprentice.

Responsibilities:

- Construct, maintain, and repair overhead and underground lines.
- Work safely within established industry practices.
- Climb poles; use hand tools (chainsaws, shovels, etc.); handle ropes and knots; dig holes.
- Assist with tree trimming and work in all weather conditions for extended hours.
- Participate in on-call rotation and respond within 30 minutes.
- Perform or learn to work on energized 15 kV lines.
- Apprentices must attend the Vermont state apprenticeship program.

Requirements:

- Ability to meet physical demands and pass a physical and drug test.
- Professional, courteous, safety-focused work ethic.
- Ability to obtain a Vermont Class A CDL within one year.
- Must join the IBEW union after six months of employment.
